

# Festival Technical Intern

## Dartington Music Summer School & Festival 2021

*To join the Summer School team and assist in the delivery of the festival programme, developing a broad range of skills that could be applied to a career in live sound and event production.*

### ROLE RESPONSIBILITIES:

- You will spend the first two weeks of the internship familiarising yourself with the festival programme and its technical requirements, alongside informal training on in-house equipment.
- During the four weeks of the festival, you will be a key part of an intimate team of technicians responsible for the delivery of a packed programme of concerts and events, working alongside industry professionals, renowned musicians and production volunteers.
- Your responsibilities will include assisting in the set-up of performance spaces, liaising with performers regarding technical requirements, managing sound checks, setting-up the filming and/or live-streaming equipment as required, problem solving technical difficulties and supporting the successful production of the live concerts and events.
- In addition to the varied day-to-day tasks, there will be the opportunity to take the lead on a specific area of work within the festival, which can be adapted to your interests with support from relevant members of the team.
- On-site accommodation will be offered for the duration of the internship. During the Summer School meals will also be provided and, due to the long hours required, time off in-lieu will be given within the 8 week period of the internship.
